SAN JUAN, Puerto Rico, Oct. 3—A giant Pan-American cliper, enroute from Miami to San Juan with 21 passengers and six crew nembers, "water looped" as it landed in the seaplane channel today and

verturned. Pan American Airways officials reported? 1at 19 of the 21 passengers were saved and all members f the crew. Two babies were reported missing, but ope was expressed that they may have been picked up y one of the many small boats in the harbor.

Among the passengers, who was rescued from the stricken up and taken ashore, was Lawrence T. Ritchie, 29, Boston wool mpany executive. Another Nev Englander was Lawrence Keat-

g, a Franklin, Mass., engineer.

The accident occurred as the giant sky liner was making a utine landing. Just as the ship struck the water, it suddenly oped and overturned, but did not sink.

A Coast Guard cutter, the Unalga, stationed in San Juan urbor, sped to the rescue and hauled 15 of the 27 passengers and ew out of the water. Other boats also rushed to the scene of the cident and it is believed that everyone may have been saved.

A hasty checkup on shore revealed all but the two children had been reported saved. The infants were Marie and Zuzzie Russo, who were brought aboard the clipper by their mother, Mrs. Angelina Russo at Port au Prince, Haiti.

Although a complete passenger list was not immediately available, the rescued crew members were identified as Capt. Charles A. Lorber, pilot; H. Breux, first officer; V. P. Donnelly, flight mechanic; W. Mahony, radio operator; J. Gatala and A. Calliguiri, stewards. All are Miamians.

Ritchie was identified as the head of the L. T. Ritchie Wool Co. Summar - Roston. He was on the same sure of the same of t
